regarder dehors, être sur son balcon, fumer une cigarette,




watch outside, stay on the balcony, smoke a cigarette,

être dans son jardin d'hiver, arroser ses plantes, sur une chaise longue. stay in the winter garden, spray its plants, on a longchair.




tirer un rideau, pour être à l'ombre, entièrement, à moitié,

puffs and solar curtains in the setting sun.


