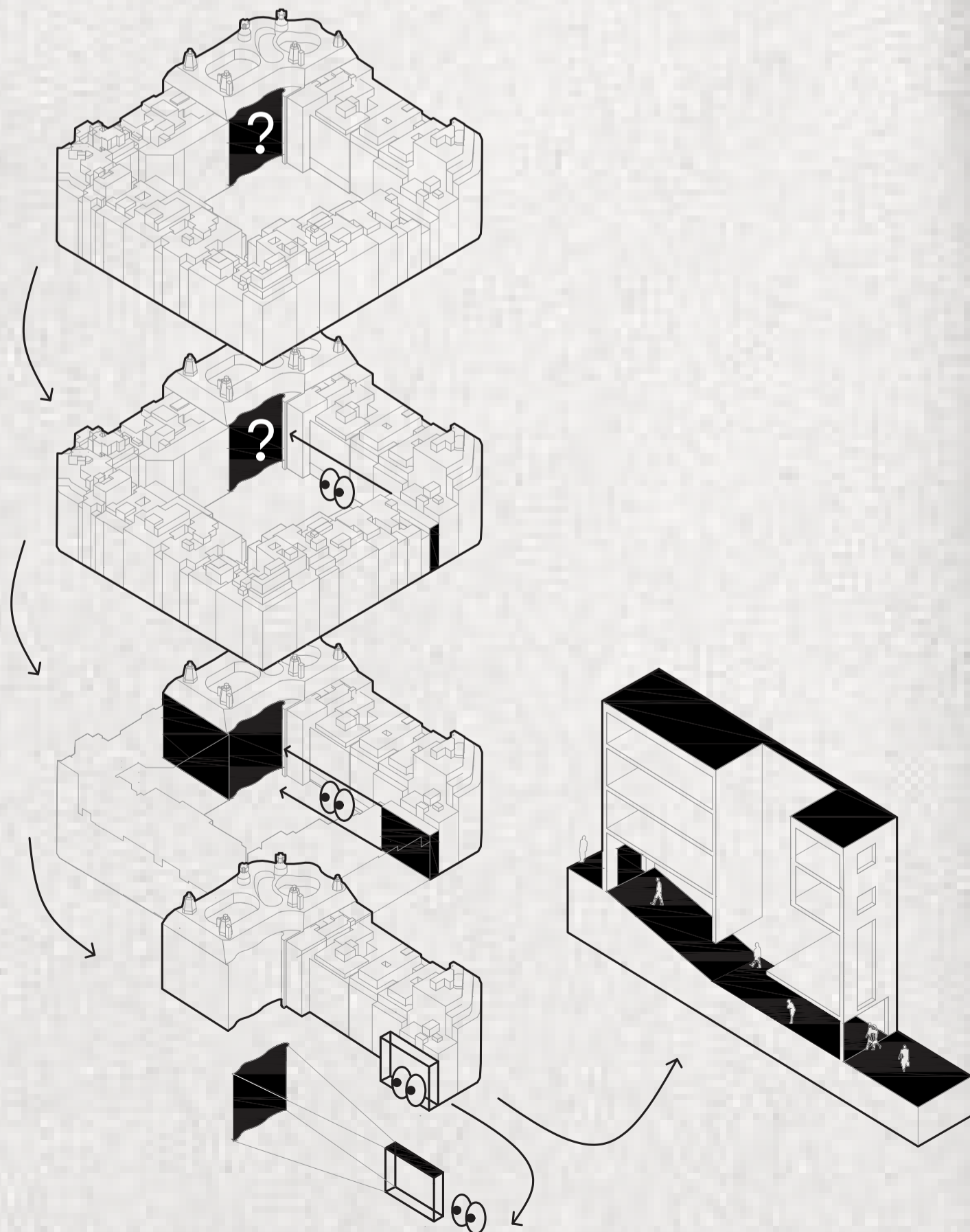

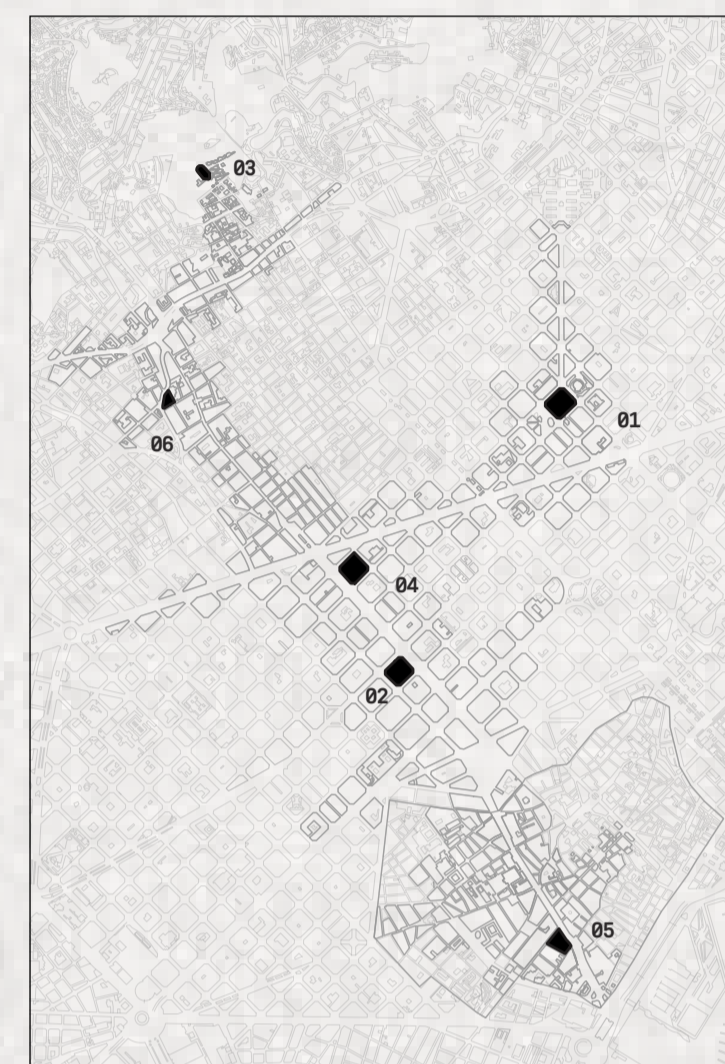
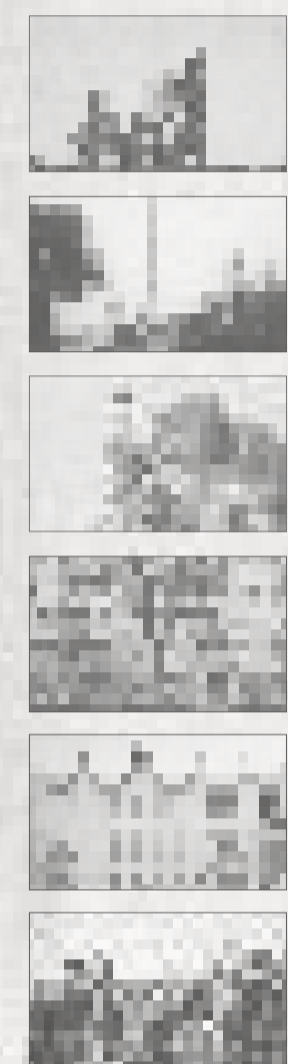

Gaudi's most visited in Barcelona

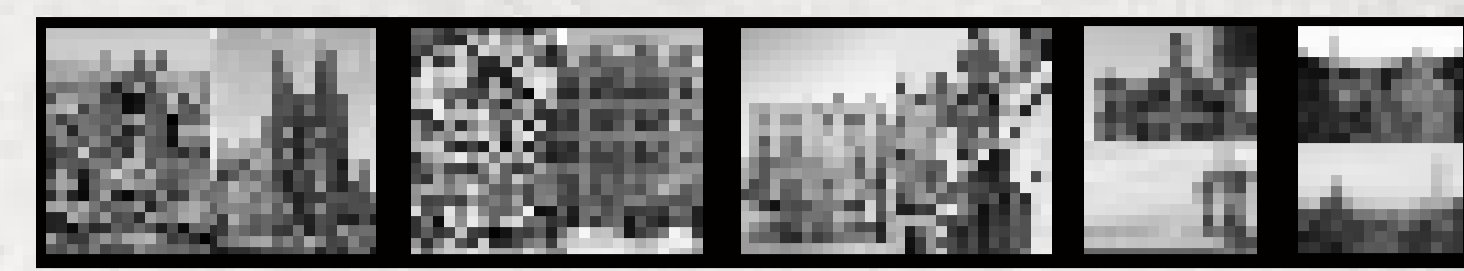


Antoni Gaudi (1852-1926) was a catalan architect known for his unique and avant-garde style that has left an indelible mark on the city of Barcelona. His most famous works, such as the Sagrada Família, Park Güell, Casa Barrió, and Casa Milà (La Pedrera), attract millions of tourists each year. Barcelona receives around 20 million visitors annually, and a large portion of them visit the iconic buildings designed by him, significantly contributing to the city's tourism. Gaudi's influence on modernist architecture and his cultural legacy make him an iconic figure in Barcelona and a key tourist attraction for the city.

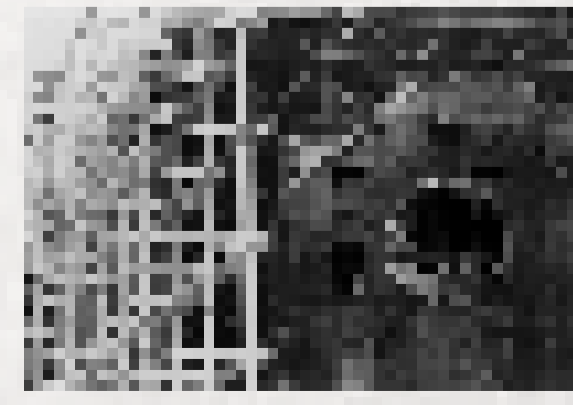
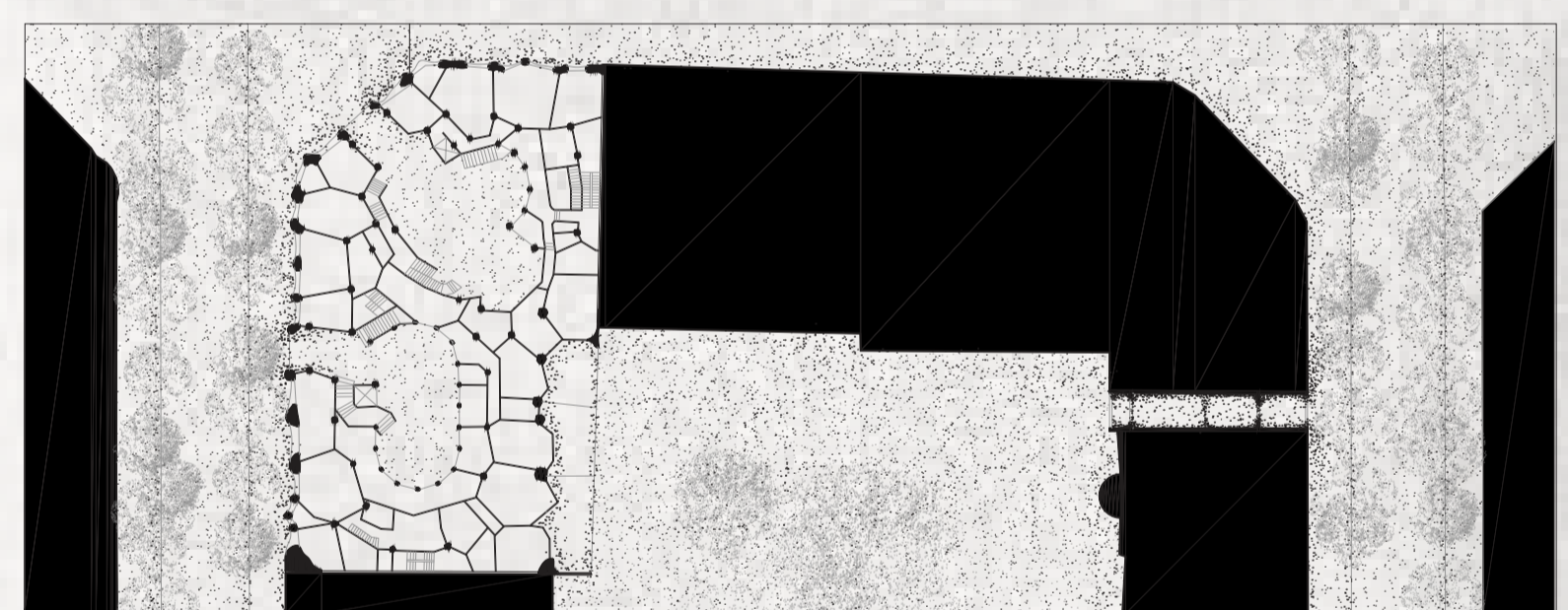
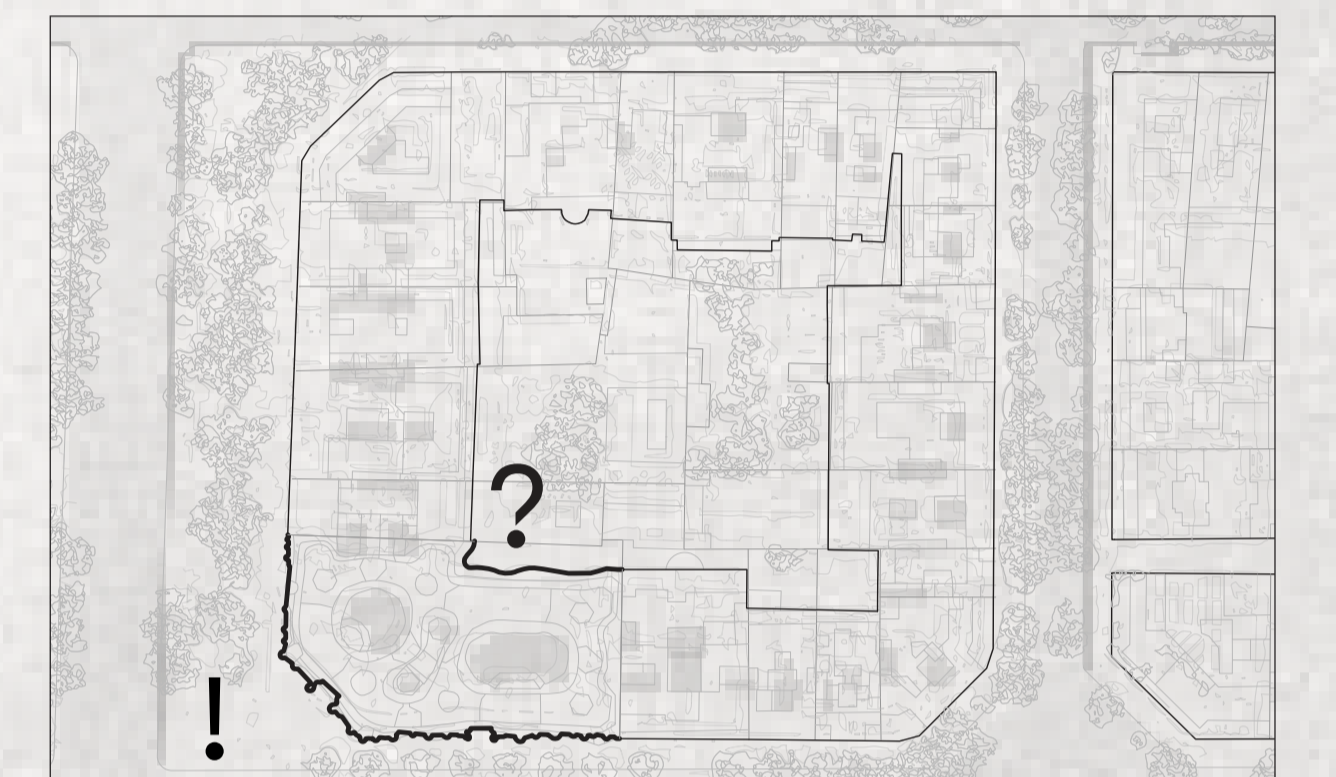
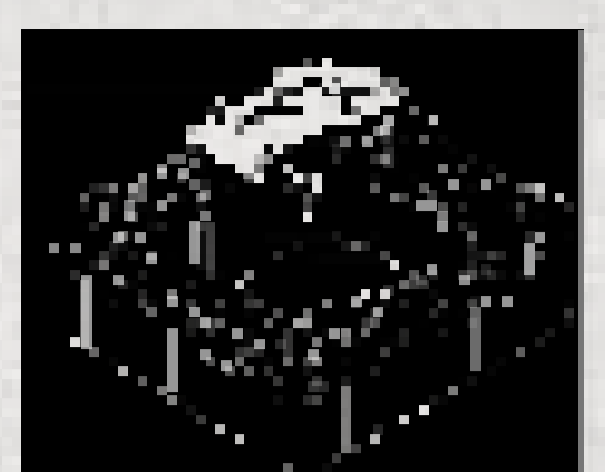
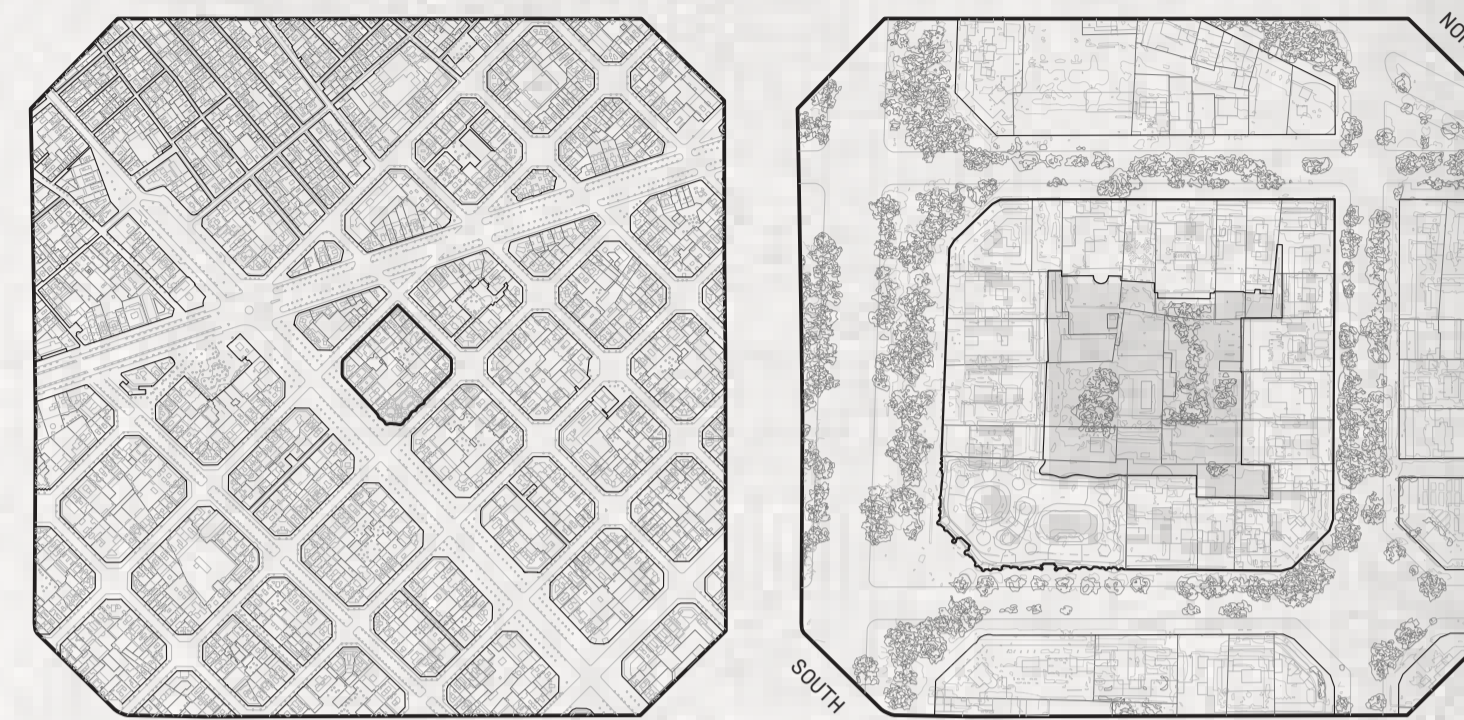

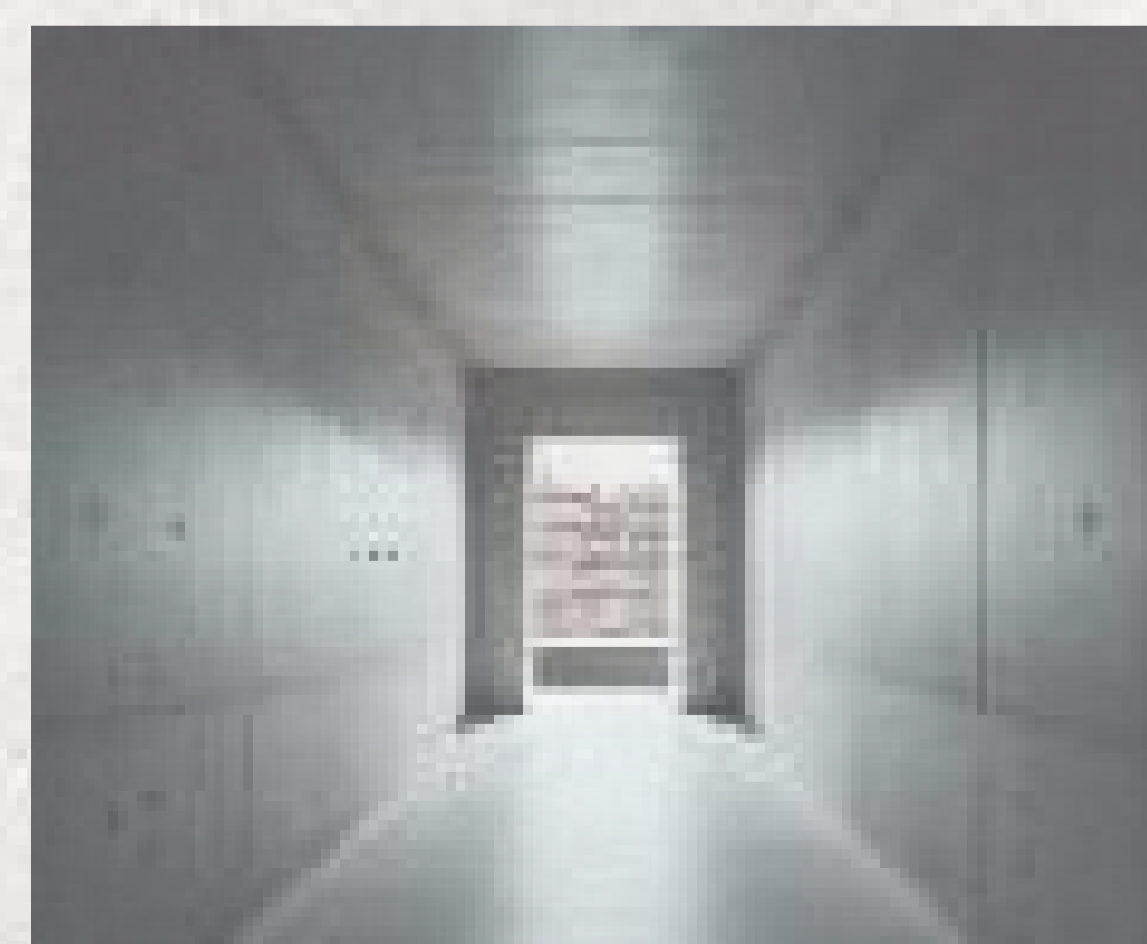
